

ALIENS DECREE 2000, SECTION 6.2

Our Minister is empowered to recover the deportation costs within the meaning of Sections 65, paragraph 2 and 66 of the Aliens Act 2000 from the sponsor, the foreign national himself or, if he is underage, from those who have or had legal custody of him, or from a carrier.

ALIENS DECREE 2000, SECTION 6.3

1. The costs of deporting a foreign national that can be recovered from a carrier pursuant to Article 65, paragraph 2, of the Aliens Act 2000, are payable to the public authority that incurred those costs.
2. The deportation costs referred to above shall in all cases include the costs related to:
 - a. the transportation of the foreign national being deported at the earliest opportunity, but using the least expensive method in view of the circumstances, to a place outside of the Netherlands;
 - b. escorting the foreign national to a place of departure from the Netherlands as well as escorting him to a place outside of the Netherlands should that be necessary, and
 - c. the accommodation of the foreign national in the Netherlands in the period after the carrier is instructed by a border control official to transport the foreign national to a place outside of the Netherlands.
